I am an experienced crocheter so I can probably work through it and make it turn out like it's supposed to. However a beginning crocheter or may have some problems figuring out where it went wrong or why their numbers aren't adding up. I do like that it is a kit and you can get started on two of the characters right away. I also like the fact that both of the Wicked Witches are included. It is a great little book with a lot of great ideas and inspiration and all of the patterns are by different artists. has it labeled as a hardcover but it is not ( in case you were wondering). Overall I gave it 4 stars because I love the book and all of the characters and the fact that it includes 12 of them instead of only the main 4 or 5... it only loses a star for having some issues with the patterns. I would still recommend the book even if you are a beginner because you won't be a beginner forever and after some practice with other things you can come back to this and know how to work it out properly. :-)

Not only did she love it, I keep getting requests to make other things for other people. The patters are really easy to follow. The only reason I didn't give it 5 stars is that it should be spiral bound. The book will NOT stay open for

anything. I have to use a binding clip on either side to read the pattern and to keep the book from closing on me. When crocheting, you kinda need both hands, so a spiral bound would have made this a lot easier. I originally rated this with 4 stars because the kit was such a wonderful idea, however I am re rating this 1 star. There are so many errors. Even if you are an experienced crocheter you still spend so much more time trying to correct the mistakes. This defeats the purpose of purchasing patterns. I would NOT recommend this product. Go to etsy and see if you can get the pattern from someone there. I am throwing this horrible book out. Every pattern has numerous errors.
