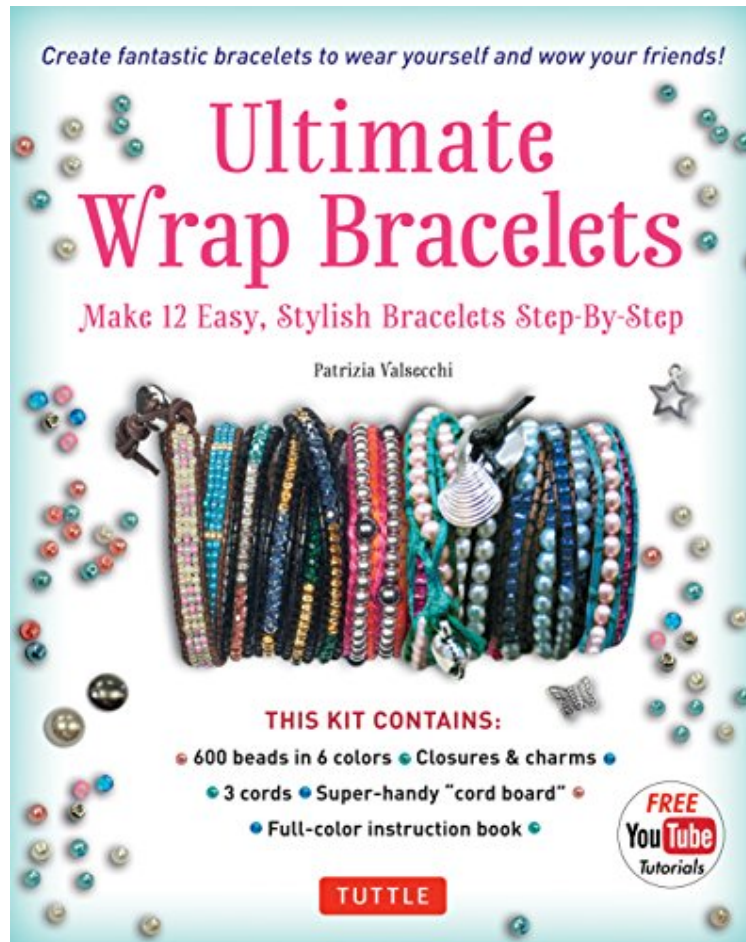

I was expecting that I could actually make the 12 bracelets with this craft kit but after receiving my kit and reading the book, I was shocked to discover that it only includes enough materials to make 3 "starter" bracelets. That part is not even true because you will need other items to even create the 3

starter bracelets. When buying a kit like this, one would expect the materials to be included. They don't even include a beading needle and thread, which are the materials needed to complete the starter bracelets, as well as any other ones you want to try with your own materials. How much do a needle and thread really cost? Was it that hard to include them? Especially since they are necessary to complete every project in the book!!! And as far as the "free youtube tutorials", anyone with internet access can view a youtube tutorial so that is definitely no bonus! I only bought this because I thought that I would be able to make the bracelets in the book with the materials INCLUDED in the kit. To be clear, the bracelets shown on the cover photo can not be made with the beads sent with the 'kit'. The beads are tiny and cheap and you aren't given the materials to thread the beads on to the cord. Oh well, there's a book at least!
