Vogue Patterns have a nice rep for sophisticated design and quality, so I thought I'd take the chance on it having patterns that were in line with the commercial Vogue Craft patterns of the last couple of decades, just maybe a little out-dated. Umm...not so much.First off, the publication info in the description is wrong. The 1st ed. clearly says it was published in 1986 by Harper Row for Butterick (which makes sense.)Second, there are 14 projects, half rag dolls/baby dolls, half stuffed toys. None of the patterns are particularly unique, and can probably be found in any cloth doll book made in the last 40 or so years. Just the standard 15-18" dolls with simple tunic dresses and a couple of accessories.The 1st 1/3 of the book covers supplies and basic sewing. For any dollmaker with a minimum of experience, that's wasted space. The 2nd 1/3rd is project instructions, the last 3rd is full-sized patterns to be traced or copied.If I'd been able to see a preview of the book, I wouldn't have bought it. But, the used price was very low, so, not much of a loss. I did like the puppy pattern, so I might make that.3 of 3 people found the following review helpful.
