It's a dictionary of stitches (cable stitches to be precise). A mindblowing collection of cable patterns all in one place. I had been searching for a guide like this. It's so nice to have everything in one book. And it's so simple to use. Each cable pattern has a name, a color photo of the finished product, and the pattern written both in long hand and chart form. So whichever method of pattern reading you prefer this book has you covered.It just lists the cable pattern so you don't have to dig through complicated sweater patterns just to pick out the section of the cable you're trying to replicate. Nice Collection of Stitches By Barbara Van Sant I enjoy looking through this book and although many of the stitches I have seen before in other books the pictures are very clear and in neutral colors which enhance the stitch pattern as well as making it easy to visualize in other colors. The directions are written and charted. Perfect! If something is unclear or I don't recall the symbol I can glance at the written pattern. One thing I would change is the orientation of the book. It is landscape rather than portrait and it makes it awkward to hold and turn pages. I also have come to prefer the spiral bound books that lie flat. All of the books in this series is landscape however that I have seen. Well worth the money and will remain a staple in my library of stitch pattern books. I think it is clear enough for even beginners to find beautiful stitches to try. I think everyone should design some of the things they make themselves in order to personalize them.
