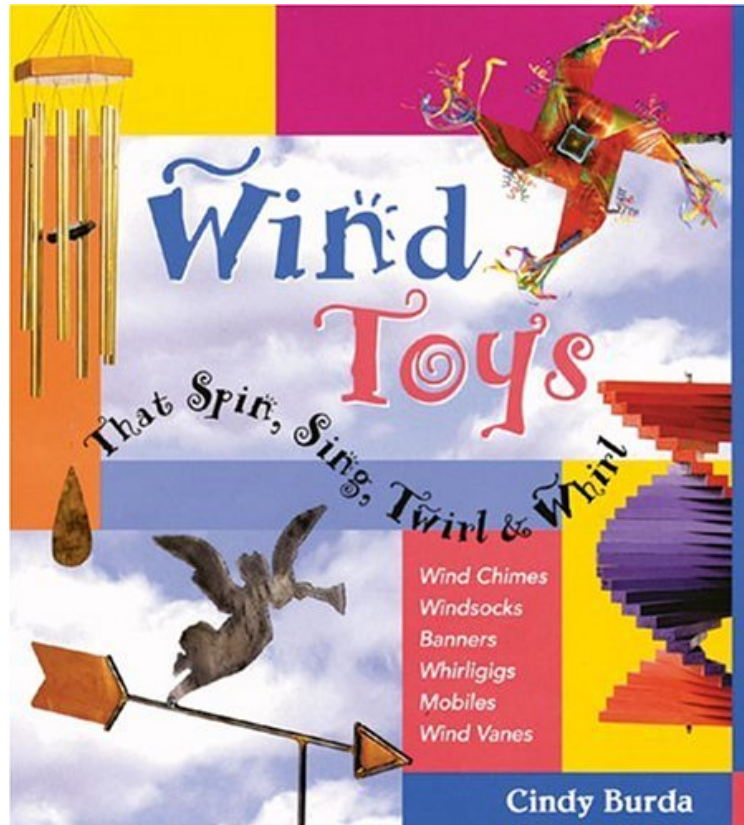

In addition to thorough step-by-step directions for every item, the introductory section explains the basics of working with each of the materials: fabric, metal, wood, polymer clay, glass, and potter's clay. Windsocks sport butterflies and dragonflies. Wind vanes appear in the shape of flying pigs, trumpeting angels, and a winged Mercury. Banners are painted, batiked, and appliqued. A collection of PVC pipes becomes a shape-shifter mobile.
